a man" seconded by Mr Low Humphris.
This proposal led to considerable discussion

as us, the Secretary advised Mr Hughes to
withdraw his motion and refer same to
the Inter-state conference which will meet
in Sydney next month. With the consent
of his seconder Mr Hughes then withdrew
his motion.
