BASIC RULES OF WOMENS LACROSSE

- Only the goalkeeper or deputy is allowed in the circle at any one time.
- 2. A player must not:
 - (a) roughly tackle/check another players stick
 - (b) use ones body or stick to touch an opponents body
 - (c) push, trip or charge
 - (d) use any part of the body to propel the ball
 - (e) shoot dangerously
 - (f) play without a stick
 - (g) cross over the goal circle with stick or body when shooting

The penalty for a foul is a 'free position'. When the whistle blows all players MUST stand and NOT move until play recommences.

A free cannot be closer than 8 m from goal and no player might be within 4 m of a player given a free position.

There are no boundaries although an umplie might stop play if she thinks the players have gone too far from the central area.
