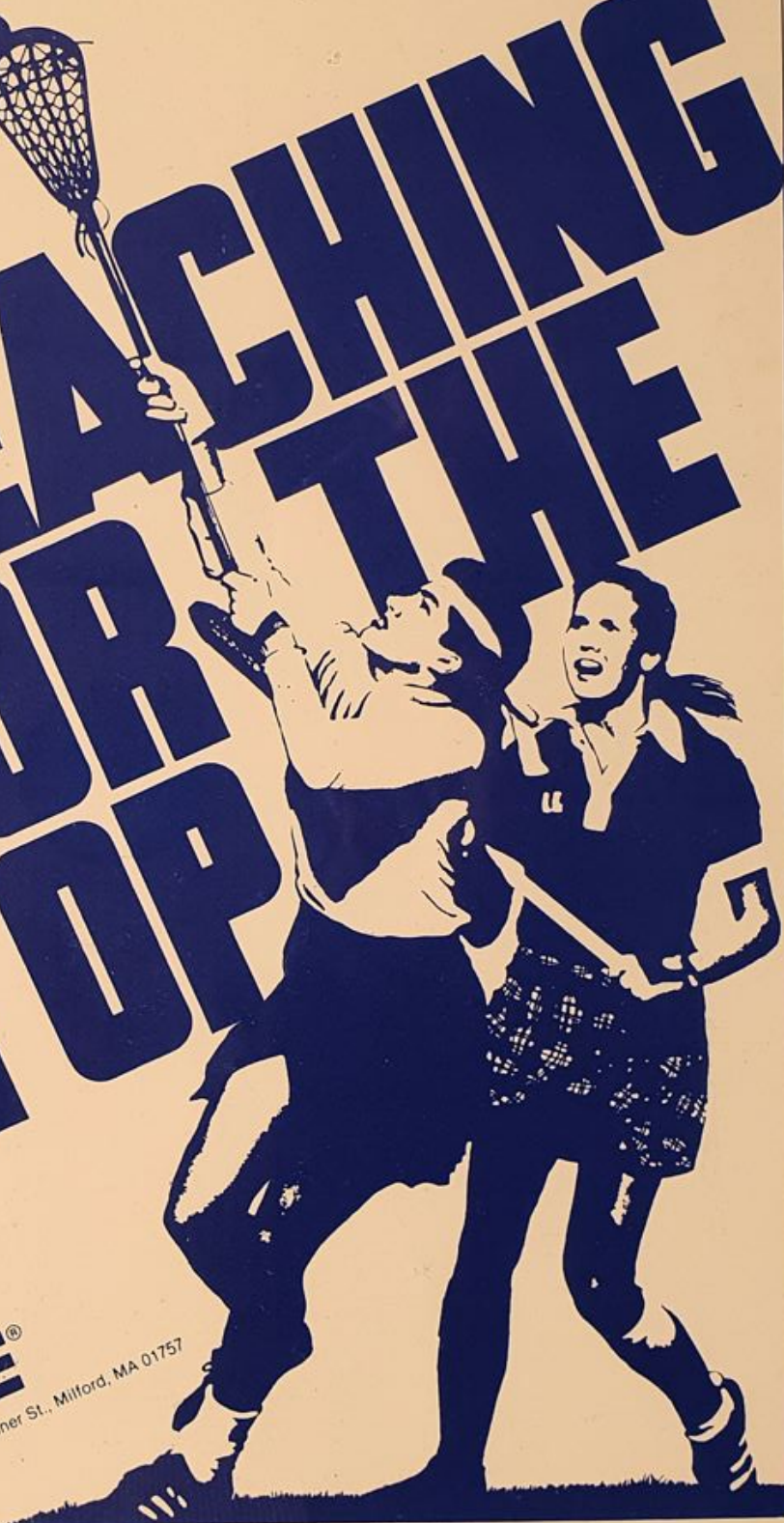

RULES OF WOMEN'S LACROSSE

Originally identical to the men's game, women's lacrosse has evolved through its own set of rules to become a free-flowing, fast, relatively simple game which is easy to understand and watch.

There are 12 women to a team; each player may go anywhere on the field; the objective is to score goals at the opposite end of a 100-yard field; there are no boundaries other than natural obstacles; playing time is 25 minutes per half.

The basic rules are to ensure safety for all players and are enforced by 3 umpires. There should be no body contact; there must be no checking with the stick around a player's head; there may not be rough or dangerous checking of the sticks; a player may not hoot for goal dangerously and/or without control. When shooting for goal, a player may not cross the circle line around the goal, either with her body or stick, before, during or after a shot. This will necessitate a goal being dis-allowed.

Players may run at will with the ball; turn their backs on opponents; dodge around other players; tackle the sticks with controlled tapping motions of their crosses; body-check without touching an opponent, i.e forcing a change in direction of a run or slowing down a player; run behind the goals (but not into the circles).

There are major and minor fouls, called by the 3 officials. All players must 'stand' at the whistle while a penalty is awarded, usually a free position with the ball as determined by the umpire.

There are 32 pages of rules in the IFWLA Rulebook; obviously the above is an over-simplified version! but hopefully, it will be of help to the casual observer of the games.

..... & EXPLANATIONS

Basically, there are attack and defending positions. The 'forward line' consists of three 'homes' - 1st, 2nd and 3rd Home, each trying to manoeuvre close to the goal for a shot.

They are fed by 2 attack wings - Left Attack Wing and Right Attack Wing, who are usually the speedy runners, ever-ready to break through to score.

Linking the defending end of the field with the attack is the Center, the workhorse who must go both directions in never-ending motion.



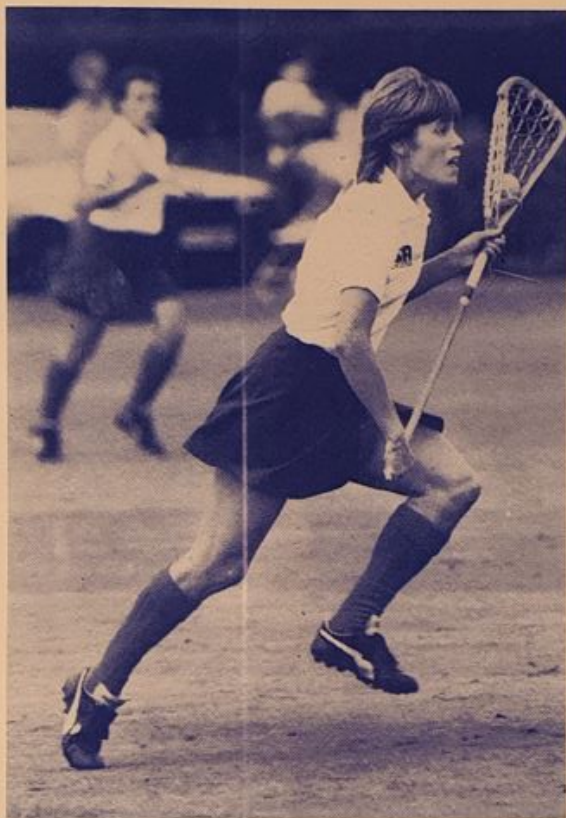
Two defense wings - Left Defense and Right Defense Wing assist in marking the opposing attack wings, and dropping back to defend and/or slow down an attack.

The deep defense are the Third Man, Cover Point and Point, who mark the 3 Homes and try to prevent shots on goal.

The Goalkeeper is the first and last player on any team, quick to react, courageous and athletic, protected only by minimal padding and the welcome circle around her goal.

Spectators will see man-to-man marking in some games, zone guarding in others. They will note the similarity to basketball, with the use of spaces, cutting and feinting. More often than not, there will be enough goals scored to make it an exciting game to watch.

Carol Moore Rowe, 1932-1986.

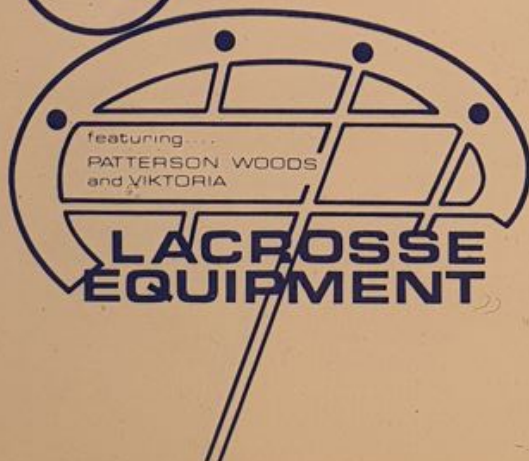

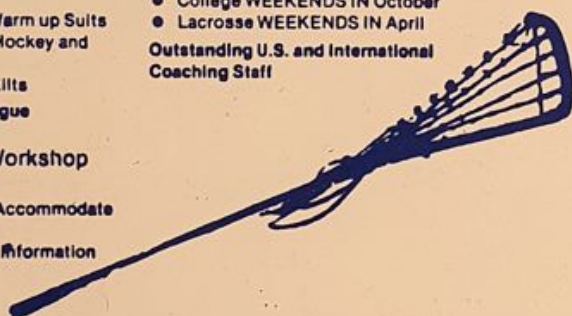
