Held at the Exchange Hotel, on Wednesday, May 29.  
Present - The Chairman (Mr Edmunds)  
& about 30 members.

Minutes of Annual Meeting read &  
confirmed.

Secretary of Junior Assn (Mr Wilson)  
wrote asking that a hearing might be  
given to Mr C. V. Smith, representing the  
Junior Assn, on the motion to be submitted  
by Mr Rudd. Hearing granted & letter received.

Mr A. Rudd moved the following  
motion of which he had given notice :-

Any member of a club in the Junior Association may play for any club in the Senior Association other than that representing the district in which he resides on receiving the permission of the Senior Association, which shall be granted only on the written application of such player within a period of four weeks after the commencement of the season's matches as arranged by the association. Should such permission be granted and the player avail himself of it he shall play for no other club in the Senior Association during that season.

Mr W. Lang seconded the motion. Mr C. V. Smith protested agst the carrying of the motion on behalf of the Junior Assn.

Messrs Blockey, Naughton, Hughes, Cox, Tonkin, Lepp & Whyte took part in the discussion, & the motion was carried by 10 votes to 5. New rule to be inserted as 28 A.

A consequent amendment to rule 28 was carried by the insertion of the words "and those hereinafter excepted" after the words "University Club."

Mr G. Blockey moved & Mr W. Fisk seconded "that, subject to the approval of the Australasian Lacrosse Union, section 8 of rule 12 in the laws of lacrosse imposing a penalty for kicking the ball be suspended for the present season, provided that a ball kicked into the net shall not count a goal." Carried by 10 votes to 6.

Mr M. J. Naughton moved the following motion of which Mr Steele had given notice at the annual meeting :- "That in the event of the scores being level at the call of time, the play shall be continued until a goal has been scored by either side, the extra time not to exceed 15 minutes."

"If no goal is scored in that time the game shall be counted a draw."

Mr Mc Bean seconded the motion which was negatived by 10 votes to 5.

Mr O. Tonkin moved "That notwithstanding the disagreement of the Victorian Assn this Assn adheres to its previous resolution nominating Mr A. Rudd as arbitrator in the event of the selectors in the test matches with Canada not agreeing upon their choice of team".

Mr H. Fisk seconded. Carried.

The members proceeded to ballot for a selector to act for South Aust in picking the test match teams. Mr L. Humphris & Mr A. S. Mann were nominated, & Mr Humphris received 10 votes & Mr Mann 9, the latter to be asked to take the position in the event of Mr Humphris being unable to witness Victoria's practice match on July 13. In the event of either being unable to fulfil the duties the Chairman (Mr C.A. Edmunds) was unanimously requested to take the position.

Mr Rudd reported that he & Mr Mann had picked 20 players to practise for the test matches in accordance with Mr Kell's motion at the annual mtg, & that they had submitted the names to the third member of the Selection Committee Mr Humphris who was absent in the country.

7. From the Secretary of the Football League submitting new interstate colours suggested for adoption by the sports conference on the subject. On the motion of Mr Gooden seconded by Mr Fletcher it was unanimously decided to adopt the colours - Turquoise blue & brown.

Mr G. Blockey gave notice of motion to strike out section 8 of rule 12 in the laws of lacrosse which imposes a penalty for kicking the ball, provided that a ball kicked into the net shall not count a goal.

Mr H. W. Hodgetts gave notice of motion to strike out of section 1

of rule 1 in the laws of lacrosse  
the words "which must not be

Mr D. M. Steele gave notice of the  
following motion: - "That the
