A competitive field lacrosse tournament for over 35's.

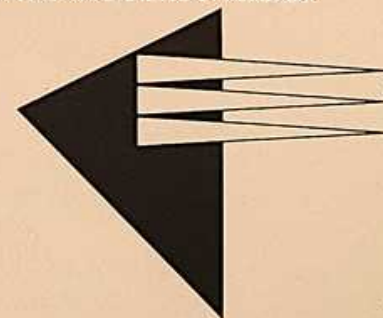
The Grand Masters
