



Under 19 World Championship

The 3rd U19 International Women's Lacrosse Federation World Championship in conjunction with the U19 International Lacrosse Federation Championship will be held at Towson University, Baltimore, Maryland, USA from Thursday June 26th – Sunday July 6th 2003.

This will mark the first time in history that a women's and men's world championship has been held jointly.

Towson University (www.towson.edu) is located in the northern suburbs of Baltimore City. It is approximately 2 hours from Philadelphia and 25 minutes from the capital of Maryland (Annapolis). The campus has undergone a major redevelopment of the sports precinct, with 31.5 million dollar renovations. The seating capacity in the main arena is 11 000, with additional fields located around the perimeter of the main stadium.





The Trophy has been crafted by a local lacrosse enthusiast, Rob Speakman, and painted with indigenous designs by Daryl Nayler to symbolise friendship and camaraderie - the essence of this event.

The overall design represents the coming together of two groups of people - depicted by the different colours of the goannas. The goannas are heading towards a common meeting place, depicted by the dots in the right hand bottom corner of the design. The colours are traditional to the indigenous world and represent the traditional, culture and lore of aboriginal Australia.

The Down Under Cup logo represents the contribution, involvement and unity of various people - depicted by the many handprints. The handprints also represents diversity yet connection. Once again using traditional colours of the indigenous world.
