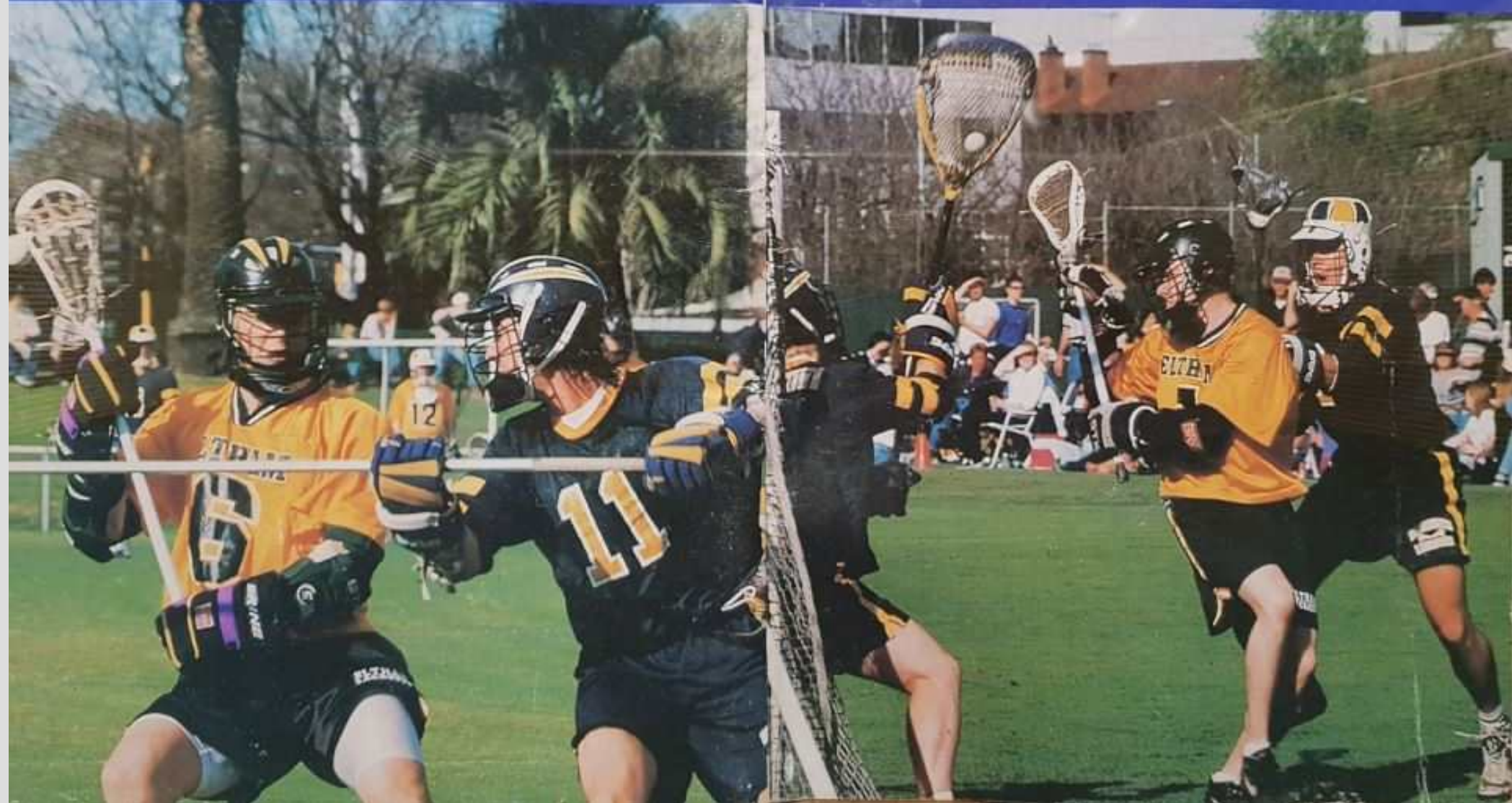

## Lacrosse Victoria

Lacrosse Victoria is an organisation formed by the Victorian Lacrosse Association and the Victorian Women's Lacrosse Association. As separate organisations both the VLA and the VWLA would be unable to support full time staff to promote the sport. By joining forces and with support from Government, Lacrosse Victoria is able to conduct recruitment 'clinics' on request as a continuous program of recruitment. The successful primary and secondary schools campaign is arranged by staff of Lacrosse Victoria. For 2000, the program in primary schools will be linked to club recruitment, the strategic plans of the VLA, the VWLA and Government initiatives. ## The Lacrosse Foundation

The Victorian Lacrosse Foundation was established in 1999 as a joint initiative of the Victorian Lacrosse Association and the Victorian Women's Lacrosse Association for the purpose of accumulating funds over a period of time for the permanent benefit of men's and women's lacrosse in Victoria.

The initial fund raising target of the VLF is \$ 1.0 million and the emphasis of the Fund is on maintaining the capital of the Fund intact and spending the interest earned on approved projects in the areas of:

- Junior development
- Administration
- Publicity and Promotion of Lacrosse in Victoria

The Fund is backed by a legally constituted Trust Deed, which defines the purpose of the fund and ensures that the interest on the funds accumulated is used for appropriate projects.

The Fund is administered by a Group of five Trustees comprising the respective Presidents of the two Lacrosse Associations and three Club Presidents. The inaugural Trustees are John Harris, Shelley Maher, Fergus Stewart, Travers Stow and Colleen Hunter.

The intent of the fund is to raise money through special efforts, donations, a 'wills and bequests' scheme and any other means approved by the Trustees.

The immediate next steps in the development of the Foundation are the establishment of a bank account, and an application to the Australian Sports Foundation for affiliation, which will enable the VLF to offer tax deductibility status to its donors.

The plan is that the establishment of the VLF will enable today's supporters of lacrosse to make and receive recognition for contributions, which will ensure that the sport grows stronger in the future.

## Club Tournaments

The Under 13 and Under 15 grades are split into two zones for the 2000 season. (This appears likely to continue as there has been steady growth in these grades over the past two years.) The Association is concerned that the zones do not develop unevenly. In conjunction with the Under 17 National Championships there will be simultaneously a club team tournament for Under 17, Under 15 and Under 13 grades.

## Under 17 Tournament

Three American teams will be joining the tournament and club teams will have an opportunity to play against American Lacrosse Camp teams.

Queensland has signalled that teams from Queensland will be participating.

## Under 13 Tournament

To be held in Melbourne from Saturday 1 July to Saturday 8 July. The venue will be the Caulfield Lacrosse Club. Club teams from the east and west zones will play off.

## Rutgers University Visit

Rutgers University will be touring Australia during 2000 and it is understood that their visit to Melbourne will be at the same time as the National Under 17 Championships and Club Tournaments. Eltham club has been appointed to host the Rutgers visit. The details of the visit will be made available as they become known.

## Under 15 National Tournament

To be held in Perth from 23 September to 30 September.

Under the rules of the tournament, teams must be formed from three clubs. The growth of Under 13 lacrosse is such that the composition of:

- Western Metros
- Eastside Kings
- Southern Cross

may need to be reviewed.

All teams are required to have a coach, a manager and a referee.



## Things to know during the season

### Insurance

All players and helpers are required by the Association to be insured. The registration of players automatically achieves insurance cover but clubs need to give a list of parents or helpers who regularly assist with conducting matches. No charge is made for insuring helpers as these people often change and help with a variety of tasks. It is important that names and addresses of people who assist are recorded.

The cover is gap insurance for selected items not covered by private or public medical insurance.

The major part of the insurance protects local councils against damages to council or private property or injury to other people using a lacrosse venue. Normally councils will not allow access to a ground unless a certificate of currency is produced. The current liability cover required by Councils is between \$3m and \$5m.

Certain details are required to be completed and the normal procedure is to provide information to the Association before the start of the season so the access to grounds may be gained at the appropriate time. Clubs who do not provide information by the due date will be directed to provide the information on an individual basis.

Please note that because public and private liabilities for clubs is involved private insurance may not be substituted for the insurance arranged by the Association.

Claims for insurance must be made using the standard form provided by the insurer. Some simple steps will assist in making the easier:

- Before attending a doctor or hospital obtain a claim form from the club secretary. (Finding a doctor to sign forms after you have been treated is often very difficult.)
- Forms must be completed by you and the attending medical practitioner, two forms are required:
  - A sporting Accident Report (To be completed by the player.)
  - Attending Physicians Statement (To be completed by the medical practitioner.)
- Make sure you obtain and keep all doctors certificates and staple them to the forms.
- Photocopy all documents and retain the copy before you send them to the insurance company. This will assist if the forms are lost anywhere in the system.
- Forward to the insurance company. Allow four weeks for

processing.

### Finals

The home and home competitions for the season lead to a final four top teams. These teams play off in first and second semi finals, a preliminary final and a grand final.

#### First and Second Semi Finals

Teams three and four play off in a first semi final. First and second on the ladder play off in a second semi final.

The loser of the second semi final and the winner of the first semi final play off in a preliminary final. The winner of the preliminary final plays off in a grand final with the winner of the first semi final.

The first named team in a finals fixture is the home team and carries all home team responsibilities.

### Scoring and time keeping

Each Saturday, teams are expected to provide scorers and timekeepers for the match - one scorer/timekeeper from each team. This practice continues throughout the finals.

### Reporting Scores

Clubs are to phone scores for all games, both junior and senior, by 10.00am on the Sunday morning following the games.

For many years Neil Clough has arranged for scores to be phoned to an answering machine. This arrangement is a private service provided by Neil. The score are then relayed to daily newspapers to appear in the Monday edition of Melbourne newspapers.

When scores are not in the newspapers it means that either clubs have not phoned through the scores or that newspapers have not provided space.

Team sheets must be legible!

### Stocks of team sheets

The Association provides one pad of team sheets for each team entered. If clubs require additional pads, a charge covering printing costs is made. This procedure avoids the situation where large clubs gain a financial advantage over smaller clubs.

### Fines

In general the Association avoids fining clubs except where non-compliance affects others. For example, there is a heavy fine for not notifying other clubs and referees if there is a walkover. Where there are

lesser incidents the current practice is to encourage clubs to correct the incident of its own decision rather than impose a fine.

For 2000 the following fines apply:

By law 57.1.7.3	Incorrectly dressed Club referees	Penalty 5 units

Bye law	Appeal against the Commissioner	40 units (forfeited if the appeal is lost)
Bye law	Appeal against Permit Committee	40 units (forfeited if the appeal is lost)

### Match Presentation

Clubs have agreed that the presentation of matches must be of a minimum standard. Late in 1999 the following equipment was agreed as being the minimum for home matches:



### **State League, Division 1, Division 2, Under 17, Under 15**

Bench area marked out and roped. Rope attachments closest to the boundary line to be safe for players playing close to or over the boundary line.

Both the home and visiting team to be supplied with a bench large enough to seat six players.

A table and chairs to be provided for scorers and time keepers. An effective weather shelter for protection from inclement weather to be erected prior to the game.

At least two penalty chairs for each team.

A scoreboard is desirable.

### **Players**

All players in open age to Under-15 grade are to be dressed in the club uniform with numbers attached to the front and back of the playing top. The emphasis is on uniformity. Items of clothing which are not uniform will be penalised. Under garments must be of the same colour for each player and match the base colour of the team uniform.

New, brighter playing uniforms for the year 2000 season and beyond are highly desirable.

Planning new presentations of the existing colours of the club is encouraged but clubs must submit changes of design to the Association for approval. The existing colours of should be retained and effort given to improving the style and design of uniforms. Appropriately sized and located sponsors logos are encouraged.

**Short playing tops which allow under shirts or singlets to become loose are not allowed.**

Encouragement should be given to all players to wear uniform coloured footwear.

All clothing and footwear must be reasonably presented (ie in good repair and clean).

Some latitude will allowed in Under-13 and Under-11 grades as these are development grades.

Clubs should recognise the value of appropriate uniforms in these grades for promotional purposes.

### **Procedures When a Player is Reported**

Reports regarding issues on the field of play can only be considered if reported by an appointed referee, bench official or head coach of a participating team.

If a referee makes a report he shall notify the player(s) concerned advising them of the grounds for the report and shall also notify the

bench officials unless the incident occurs after the final whistle to complete the game.

If reported by a bench official or head coach the referee shall call a time out at the next dead ball and notify the referee of the player(s) who he/she is reporting. The referee shall then notify the player(s) reported and the bench officials.

The report must be in writing setting out the details of the report and be signed by the person making the report. The report must be lodged with the Permit Committee or the Commissioner before noon on the Tuesday following the match.

To assist the Commissioner information provided should include names and numbers of players and any others involved and names of any witnesses. Contact phone numbers for all of the above if possible.

### **Notification Of Walkovers**

Walkovers fall into two categories:

Notified

Unnotified

#### **Notified walkover**

An official of the opposing club must be notified by phone by, if possible, 9.00pm on the Thursday prior to the scheduled match. Notifications after 6.00pm on the Friday preceding the game will not be accepted as 'Notified' walkovers. Notifying clubs must record the name of the official of the notified club.

The referee's representative must also be notified in the same manner. For 2000 the referees representative is Noel McDonald, telephone: 9807 3946

#### **An Un-notified Walkover**

Any walkover where the opposing club, and/or the umpire's representative are not correctly notified. Un-notified walkovers are subject to a mandatory fine. The current maximum fine is 50 units (currently \$2.50 per unit) for senior sides per un-notified walkover. An additional 5 units will be charged for failure to correctly notify the referees.

**Association Fees**

Club fees as determined by the VLA Management Committee will be charged to affiliated clubs. They will be invoiced as a per head charge, utilising the preceding year's final team registration list.

Association fees for year 2000 are:

Seniors	\$106
Under 17	\$63
Under 15	\$52
Under 13	\$40
Under 11	\$30

This is an increase on the 1999 charges which was identified at the 1999 AGM. Invoices for club fees will be forwarded during March 2000. The fees will be payable as follows:

One third by April 30  
One third by June 30  
One third by August 31

Other charges to clubs may be made throughout the year for VLA Permit Committee fines, additional Premiership Medallions, or as the VLA Management Committee determines.

**Points system for 2000 season**

As teams compete Saturday by Saturday the following points system is used:

Win	4 points
Draw	2 points
Loss	0 points
Walkover	4 points and a score of 10 - 0 recorded.
Bye	4 points and a score of 10 - 0 recorded

All senior teams of clubs which field two under 13 teams to be awarded an additional point each Saturday when the two under 13 teams are fielded.

Where two clubs amalgamate senior teams, they will be awarded points on the following basis:

- When each of the two clubs fields two under 13 teams, each senior team of both clubs are awarded a point for each week the two under 13 teams in each club are fielded.
- When one club of the combined team defaults on fielding both

under 13 teams, no points are awarded to the combined team and no points to the other senior teams of the defaulting club. The other senior teams of the second club are awarded the additional point for each week they field two under 13 teams.

- If a club has two Under 13 teams at a date after the commencement of the season, the senior teams will only be eligible for points from the date the two under 13 teams were fielded.

**Premiership Medallions**

In an effort to encourage growth, the Association has been flexible in the playing numbers of under age teams. This flexibility is well understood until the presentation of medals at Grand Finals.

The number of medals to be presented has been fixed by the Association:

If additional medallions are required clubs may purchase them from the Association at a cost of \$10 per medal. Proof must be provided that the additional medals are for players who have participated during the season.



## Code of Conduct

The VLA seeks to provide all players, officials and supporters with a high quality, enjoyable and energetic competition.

It is expected that all involved will display, as their prime objective, good sportsmanship and fellowship in order to attain maximum enjoyment, recreation and social interaction for all concerned.

The VLA will actively encourage **all participants** to:

- Be an ambassador for lacrosse at all times.
- Show a spirit of co-operation in every aspect of the game.
- Refrain from the use of derogatory and abusive language, particularly based on gender, race or ability.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of everybody.
- Respect those in leadership positions.
- Be a proper role model to those younger than you.
- Always endeavour to develop and improve the sport of lacrosse.

The VLA will actively encourage **all players** to:

- Play by the rules.
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, ask your captain or coach to approach the official during a break, or after the game.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players is not acceptable.
- In particular, acknowledge the difficult task that referees have, and resist the temptation to abuse them in any circumstances.
- Work equally hard for yourself and the team.
- Be a sportsman and acknowledge all good play whether from your team or the opposing team.
- Actively discourage on or off the field sledging. Despite examples in other sports it is not consistent with good sportsmanship.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated yourself. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of others.

- Cooperate with your coach, team mates, officials and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- Ignore any isolated incident of unsporting behaviour you might encounter. Highlighting such behaviour is unproductive
