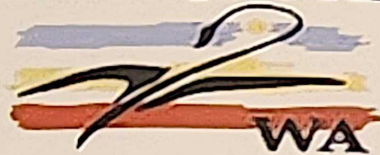

has contributed so much to raising the standard of competition in Australia and throughout the world.

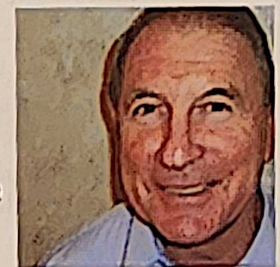
