## JUNIORS AND OUR FUTURE

Few would dispute the view that the future strength of our game lies in the strength of our junior program. Put simply, the larger the base of juniors, the larger the likely senior ranks and the stronger the competition at all levels. We can easily see why the AFL and NBL are successful if we look at the size of the base upon which they can draw players, officials and supporters. Although we can never hope to directly compete with these two codes, we should learn from them and do whatever we can to expand our base. Their size not only provides economies of scale for sharing administrative costs but it also provides lots of influence and political clout for a whole host of areas including funding from governments and media coverage. **GROWTH** must be the catch-cry of the nineties for lacrosse. **GROWTH** must be uppermost in the minds of all clubs and state associations. **GROWTH** must be a shared task if we are to succeed.

In Victoria, the governing body of men's lacrosse has made it compulsory for all State League Clubs to field two Under 13 teams from 1992 onwards. This is not a new suggestion for back in 1974 and again in 1978 the Committees of Advice recommended that the fielding of junior-age teams be compulsory. Unfortunately it has taken a very long time to implement these ideas but now that we have we should all get behind the rule and make it work. Now that your Club has recruited all these new players (and their parents) you must work hard at retaining them in the game. Look at what other clubs or other codes do to keep them interested. The object of any junior recruitment program is to get more seniors and supporters into the game so you must make newcomers enjoy the game and your Club or they will not stay. This may mean de-emphasising "winning" (after all only one team can triumph in every game) and placing more emphasis on the social aspects of being involved in a club. Whatever works best for you and your Club will soon show out by higher retention rates but research has shown that the above two aspects are important along with such things as continuing parental involvement and the coaches attitude to players and the game.

I hope that in five or six years time every existing club in all states is fielding a team at every age level including the all-important Under-17 level (or its equivalent). This group not only provides the best standard of junior lacrosse to watch but truly are the potential champions of the future. I am looking forward to these young men displaying their wares on the field at these Championships but I am even more interested in seeing all of them remain in the game along with their less gifted club mates who did not make the teams. The attitude of each of us can help retain these players in our great game so let's all work on it. If we make every player feel needed and important then the likelihood of them remaining in the game is so much better.

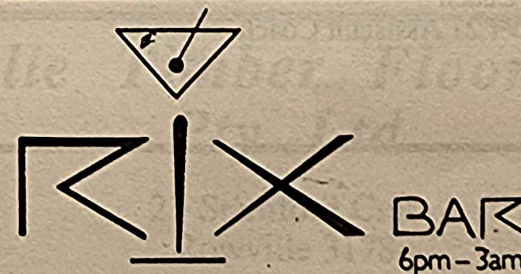

## VICTORIAN U/21 Assistant Coach's Comments

Selection trials were carried out from Sunday 26 April 1992 to 17 May 1992 resulting in 19 players and 8 alternates being selected from a list of 38. The alternates were not only included in the 7 weeks training to keep pressure on the original 19 but also to achieve a higher level of learning from a larger contingent of younger players.

Selection was viewed not only in respect of winning but also to help and guide the individual to obtain the mental and skill level needed to further their careers to both senior and international level. The criteria for selection was not only natural ability and athleticism but also being able to play in 2 positions and the ability to play to the structure of the game plan drawn up prior to the selection trials: Aggressive, running defenders and attackers are players who can straight line dodge and move continuously off ball and side!

Eight weeks practise comprising 2 hours Sunday and 2 hours Monday were utilised to form the basis of the game plan - rides, clears, 6 on 6, 6 on 5, fast breaks, dodging and short stick, defence, and finishing with special plays for both defence and attack. The whole concept has been based not only on what was seen and discussed at the World Series in Perth in 1990, but also what has been on display overseas since and our belief in what direction we should be heading in every aspect, particularly at this age level.

The object of training under 15 through to under 21 should be primarily focussed on their advancement to State and Australian teams as much as to the achievement of winning the series they are selected for at the time.

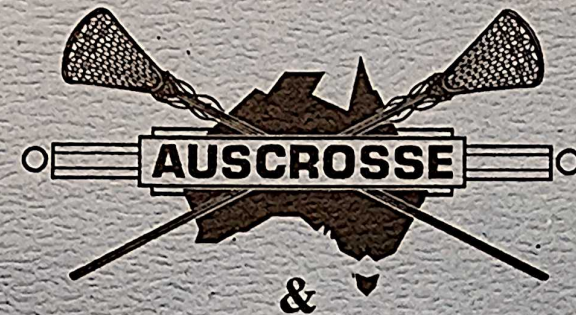
