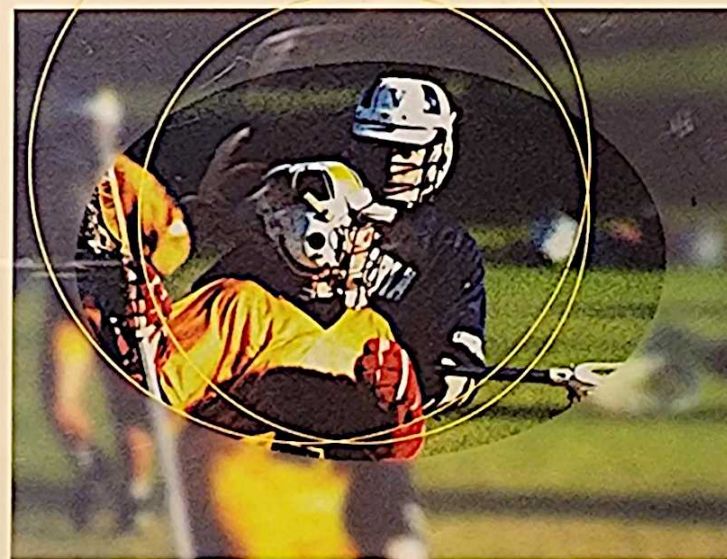

For example, National Competitions are usually high pressure games normally experienced only in Grand Final events. The selection to play in a State team to compete in National Championships is widely accepted as a statement of ability. National Championships are also an opportunity for past players to renew long standing friendships.

The event in Melbourne promises to be different, in that the Victorian Institute of Sport team competes for the first time and the Australian Under -19 team begins its preparation for World Championships in Adelaide in 1999. The lacrosse viewing public will have an opportunity to form a view at the success of both of these teams.

In any one year of local competition, there are three national events:

- Senior National Championships
 - an Under-17 National Tournament
 - an Under-15 National Tournament
- all of which carry great importance for the participants.

All of this is achieved against a backdrop of periodic international events. The lacrosse community thus presents itself as an energetic contributor to local, national and international events. The down side is that it does so in the context of declining numbers. Perhaps National Championships should also provide an opportunity to "freshen up" the conviction that lacrosse is a worthy sport for both men and women who want to step outside the mainstream.

I hope that visitors will find Melbourne a lively place to spend a "week at the Nationals" and your presence contributes to the overall staging of the event.

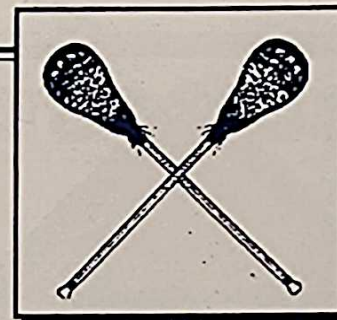

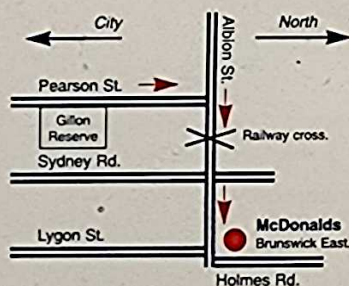
