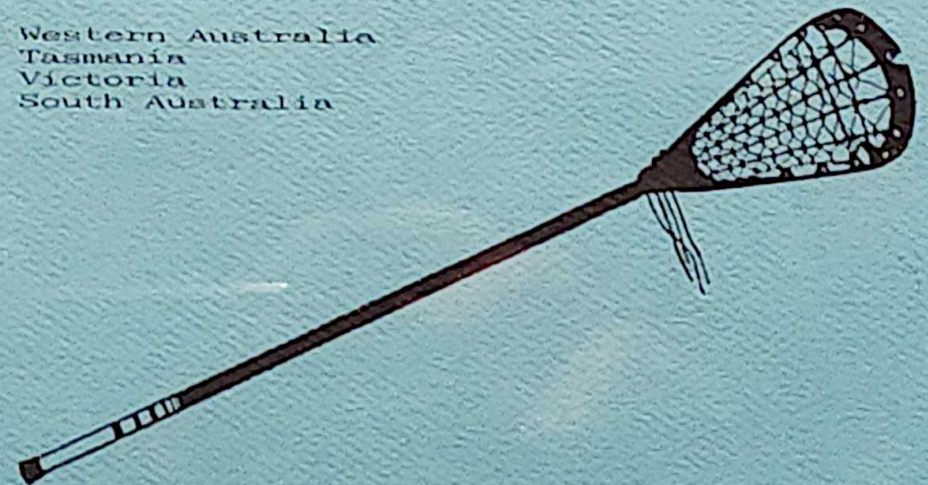

President's Message

After a gap of almost three years since the last Under 19 Championships, it is especially pleasing to see the cream of Australian teenage lacrosse players here in Adelaide to compete for the "Joy Gomer Trophy".

The U19 Nationals were started in 1983 so that girls would be encouraged to stay involved in lacrosse when they are too old for U16 State Teams but, because of the depth of players, would have difficulty getting into a Senior State team.

There are many distractions for young people, which often means losing interest in sport, but we see here this week so many girls who show by hard work and dedication that one can combine sport, studies, work and leisure very successfully.

Last year the series was due to be played in Tasmania, but because of certain problems this did not eventuate. The AWLC did not want the event to be lost so decided it would be played early this year (normally U19's are in alternate years). Tasmania will be hosting the Under 16's later in 1990 and with their limited personnel and resources could not conduct the U19's as well.

We all must sincerely thank South Australia for offering to run the event at short notice.

The venue at "The Pines" is excellent and will again see Womens Lacrosse Championships this year when the Senior Nationals will be held from July 21st to 28th.

This week we can look forward to a high standard of lacrosse played by girls who will surely hope to represent Australia sometime. See if you can "spot the potential Australian players".

I hope all the players and officials enjoy this series and that the supporters and spectators feel the future of Womens Lacrosse in Australia is secure with these players.

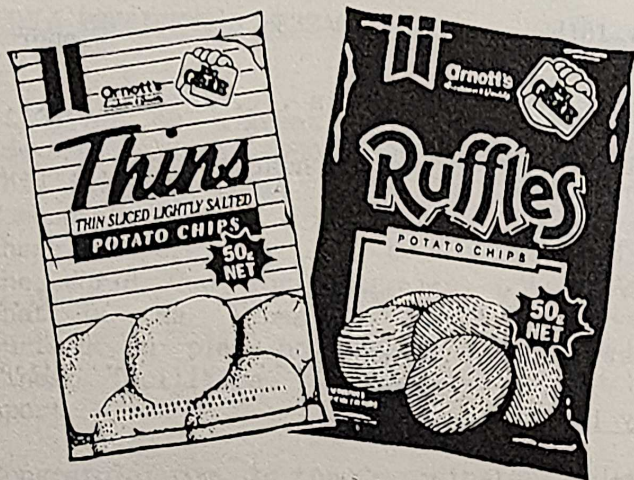

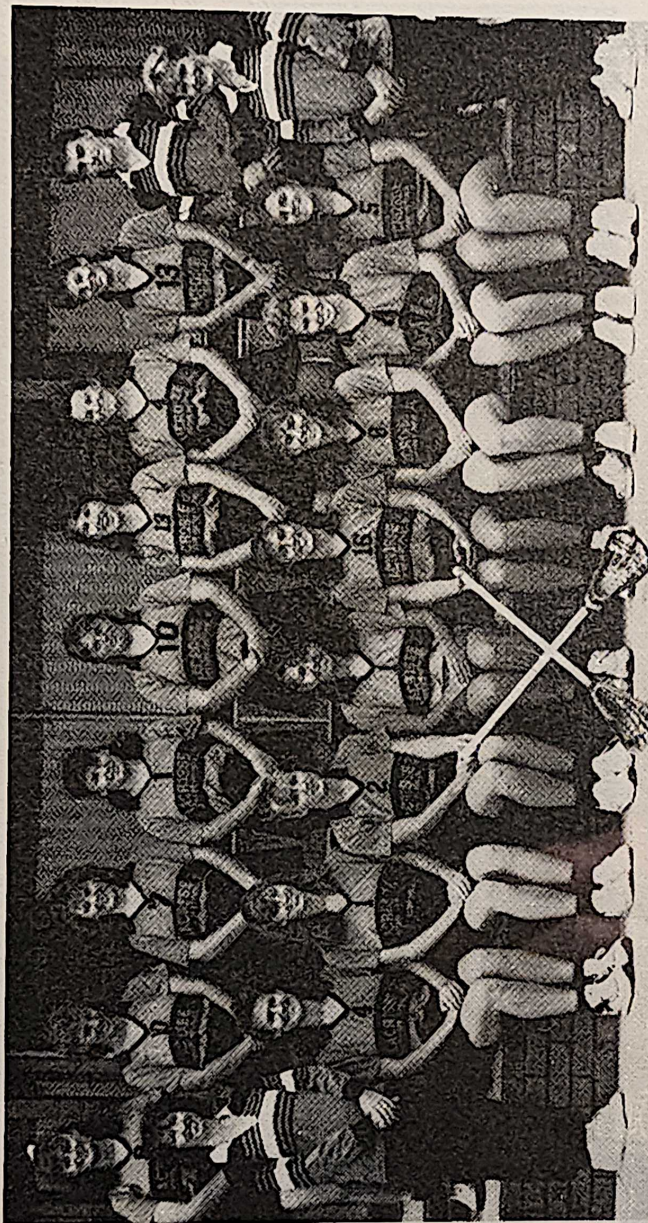
