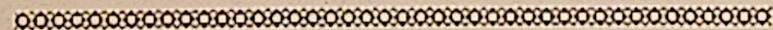


Interstate contests between Victoria and South Australia commenced in 1888 and up to 1938, inclusive, resulted:—

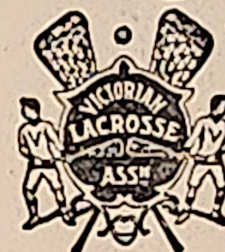
VICTORIA, won 22; SOUTH AUST., won 21.

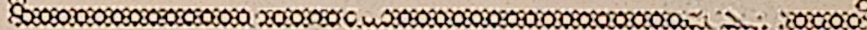
