

Ending a busy year of Victorian Lacrosse often leaves our volunteers exhausted and ready for off season recovery. Preparation for national competitions appears a daunting task as we complete our local obligations and focus upon national events. Fortunately the pleasure and excitement of hosting national competitions kicks in and the final weeks before the nationals are characterized by anticipation and a renewal of commitment to our sport. As in other parts of Australia we are heavily dependent on the good will of our volunteer work force. Our sport functions as it does because of the contribution made by many people. The 'Australian Lacrosse Classic' will be the first event of its kind to be held in Australia. 


