Victoria won 22, South Australia 21, drawn 1.

Since 1939 the two States have competed for possession of the Symonds Cup, a trophy donated by the parents of the late "Bob" Symonds (a former Interstate player for South Australia), who was killed in an air crash at Dromana in 1938.
