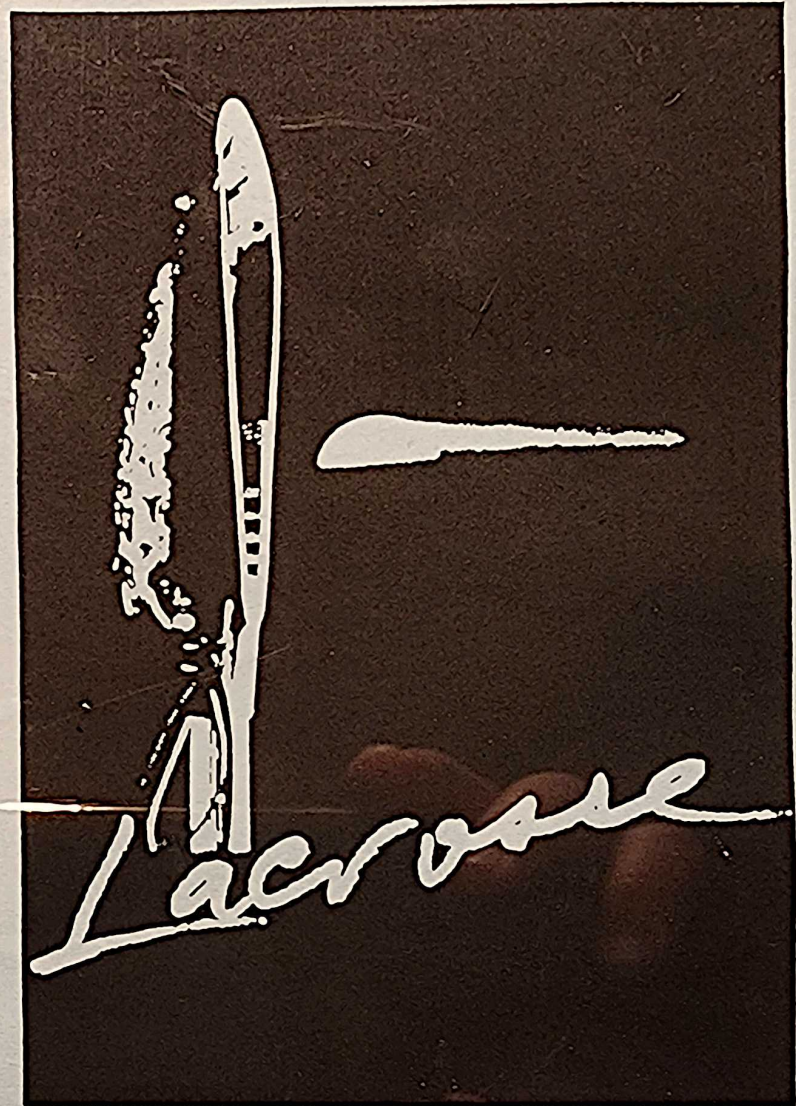

It serves as a perpetual reminder of the immense contribution made to Australian lacrosse over many years by visiting teams, and of the wonderful friendships which have been made possible through the enjoyment of this great game.

Congratulations to all participants on your achievement in being selected to be a part of this first Australian Senior Lacrosse Tournament. I wish you a successful and enjoyable competition.

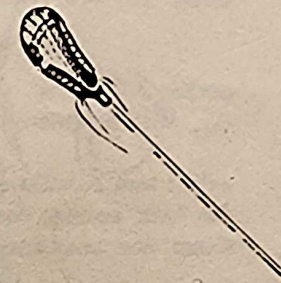

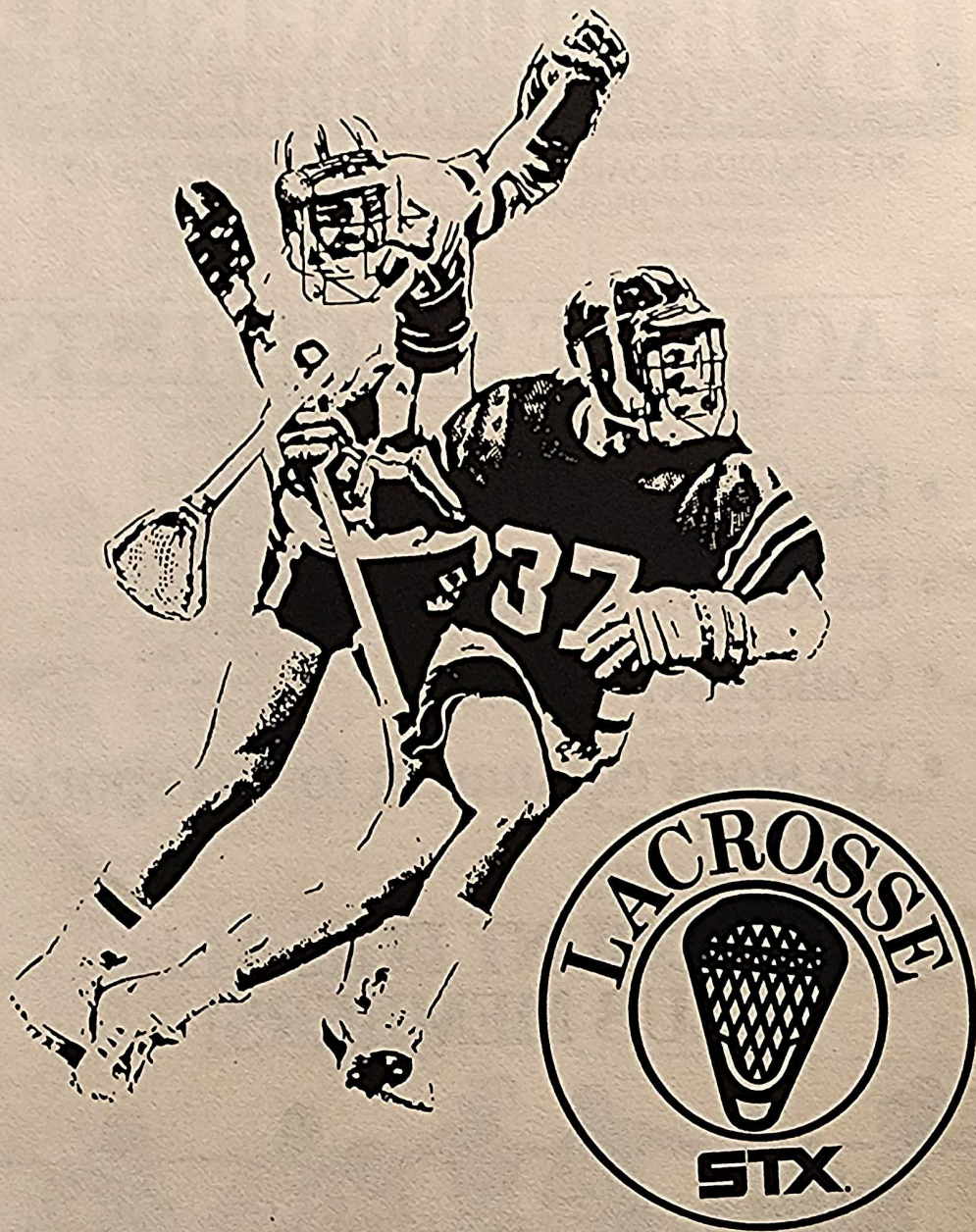

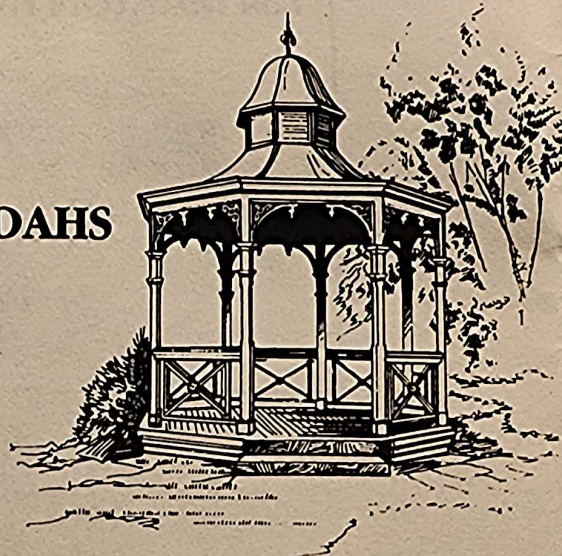
