HISTORY OF GARLAND-McHARG CUP

After the visit of the Canadian Lacrosse team in 1907, a Cup was presented by Mr. Garland (a Canadian) and Mr. A. McHarg (a Victorian) for competition between the States. The matches took place each three years until 1968, but are now played on a bi-ennial basis. Victoria have won the Cup eleven times, S.A. five times and W.A. once.
